## **DANGER**

#### **FIRST AID**

Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have the product container with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

**If in Eyes:** Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician. Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue cautiously rinsing eye.

**If on Skin or Clothing:** Take off contaminated clothing and wash it before reuse. Wash skin with plenty of soap and water for several minutes.

**If Swallowed:** Unless advised otherwise by a poison control center or doctor, have person rinse mouth with water, if able. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**If Inhaled:** Remove person to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, and then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth if possible. Call a POISON CENTER or doctor if you feel unwell.

**Note to Physician:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.
