GENERAL INFORMATION

AP Span is an effective, easy to use, adjuvant for deposition improvement and drift retardation in spraying operations. AP Span is compatible with most water soluble and wettable powder pesticides, desiccants, and cotton defoliant when applied by aerial or standard ground application.

NOTE: The degree of drift hazard varies with the type of pesticide, application conditions, and vegetation near the sprayed area. Remember, pesticide drift is no accident. Common sense and sound application technology must be followed when spraying pesticides. AP Span will retard, but not totally eliminate drift.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment wash waters. NOT FOR AQUATIC USE IN CALIFORNIA OR WASHINGTON STATE.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

REFER TO PESTICIDE LABEL FOR SPECIFIC CROP USE AND APPLICATION RATES. Prior to use, read and follow all directions on this label and on the label of the pesticide being used. The pesticide manufacturer's label for specific usages and restrictions have precedence over DIRECTIONS FOR USE referred to on this label. Fill the spray tank half to three quarters full, add pesticide components, and provide good agitation. Select proper dosage from Dosage Chart and add AP Span. If additional surfactants or spray adjuvants are to be used, they should be added after AP Span. Continue agitation until tank is full.

STORAGE: Store product locked up in original container and keep container tightly closed when not in use. Take care to prevent water from being introduced to the contents of this container.
